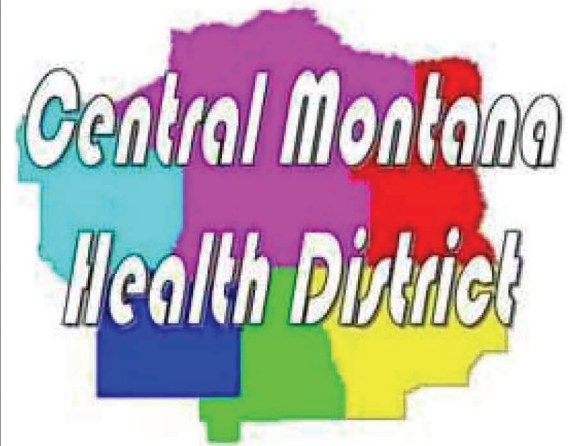

Onsite Wastewater Review & Inspection

- Permit and inspect proposed subsurface wastewater management (septic) systems to assure they are installed adequately to handle the waste load.
- Review proposed subdivisions to assure all proposals meet state and district sanitary laws and requirements.

Food & Public Accommodation Safety

- License and inspect retail food establishments and manufacturers; public accommodations, such as hotels, campgrounds and trailer courts; and pools to ensure they meet state safety requirements.
- Inspect schools semiannually to ensure facilities meet state and federal safety requirements.
- Conduct ServSafe classes to educate the public on safe food handling practices.

Bioterrorism & Emergency Preparedness

- Respond to food-related emergencies and authorize proper clean up procedures and food handling practices.
- Work cooperatively with local emergency agencies in developing and executing plans for emergency response.
